Christian Symbol



Descending Dove— The descending dove is a symbol of the Holy Spirit. “As soon as Jesus was baptized, he...saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove” (Matthew 3:16, NIV). The three-rayed nimbus around the dove’s head identifies the Spirit as a member of the Trinity. A dove shown without the nimbus is a symbol of peace.
