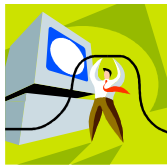


Young Adult Ministry

Our Children's Sunday School is currently meeting on Sunday mornings at 10:30 AM in our newly renovated Children's Wing where each room is thoughtfully decorated with themes to delight children from birth through 6th grade.

Each week the children are taught bible lessons which emphasize Godly character. The teaching is done by dedicated children's workers who creatively use music, games, flannel boards, puppets, crafts and performances to teach spiritual truths.

A parishioner from the Adirondack Community Church has been visiting Camp Gabriels Correctional Facility weekly since 2001. Pastor Mark Demers was chaplain for 2 years at the facility.
